

# GAGE DIAMONDS

## RING SIZING GUIDE

To ensure accuracy, please scale this PDF guide to 100% and print in US Letter size.

### OPTION #1

Measure with a string.

Wrap a piece of string around your finger, close to the knuckle

Using a pen, mark the string where it overlaps with its end

Measure the string against a ruler on the millimeter side (mm)

Reference the conversion chart below for your ring size

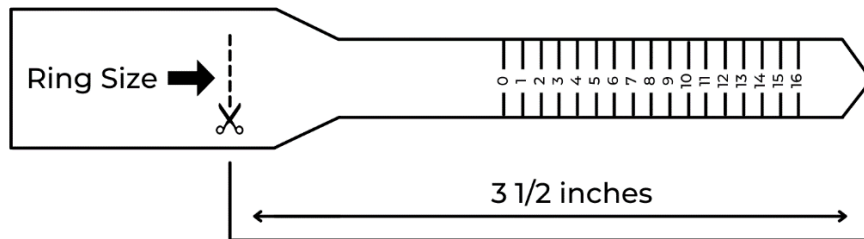
### OPTION #2

Measure with a paper sizer.

Cut along the outline of the ring sizer and make a small slit where noted

Wrap the sizer around your finger and pull the pointed end through the slit so that it fits snug

The number that lines up with the slit is your ring size



Measure the template with a ruler to ensure it was printed correctly

### OPTION #3

Measure with a current ring.

Select a ring you already own that fits your finger perfectly

Use the conversion chart below to align your ring to the circle that most closely matches in size

### CONVERSION CHART
